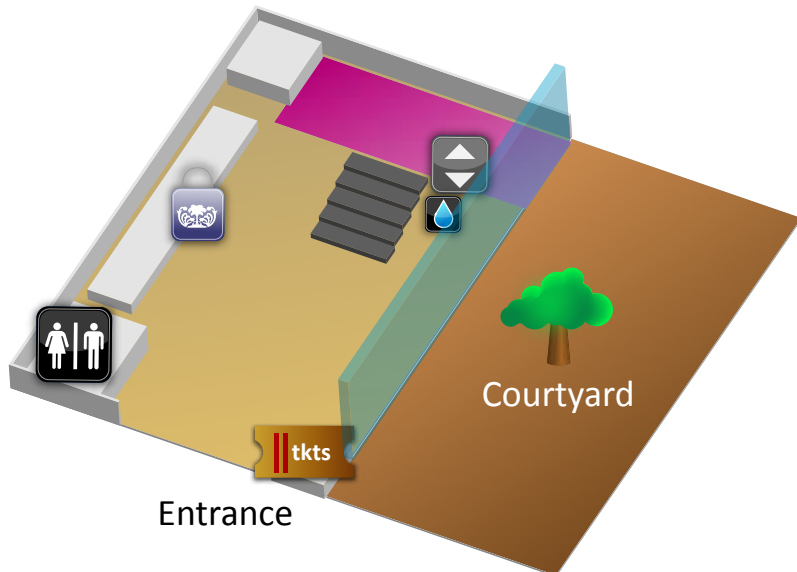
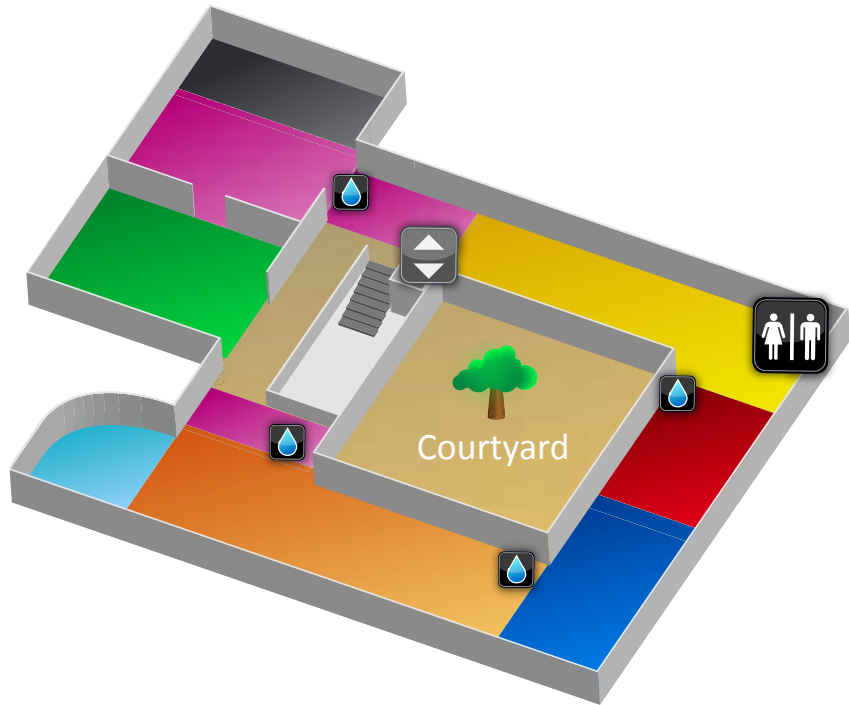




The Charleston Museum floor plan
